An Event Like No Other!

All participants in the Rock & Roll Hall of fame performance will have the opportunity to perform with a backing band of professional musicians comprised of teachers from the schools. Imagine if you are a guitar student, and you get to rock out on stage in front of an adoring audience with full drums, bass, keyboards and vocals backing YOU up with a full concert sound system! There's no better way to feel like a rock star!

Once registration is finalized, performers will pick pieces, and rehearsal times will be arranged in August for students to practice their performance with the full band. Performers are welcome to perform solo as well if they do not wish to play with the band.

Participants for the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame performance may sign up on a *first come, first served* basis starting **Wednesday, January 22nd, 2020 at 12pm**. Registration is limited to <u>30 performers</u>. To register, those wishing to participate may call or email or come in person beginning at 12pm on Wednesday, January 22nd, 2020 @ 12pm.

<u>How do I know if I should sign up?</u> Do you want to ROCK? Do you like Rock & Roll Music? If so, then sign up! Registration is open to ALL students regardless of instrument or age on a first come, first served basis.

If you are interested in signing up for the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame Performance, please contact the school by phone on **Wednesday**, **January 22**nd, **2020 at 12pm** and we will charge a non-refundable registration fee to hold your spot. After registering, please fill out the registration form attached below and return it to the front desk no later than your next lesson. What is the Rock & Roll Hall Of Fame?

The Rock & Roll Hall of Fame is a museum and hall of fame located in downtown Cleveland, Ohio, on the shore of Lake Erie. The museum documents the history of rock music and the artists, producers, engineers, and other notable figures who have influenced its development. On display are many artifacts and instruments from musicians who have left their mark on the history of rock & roll.

Transportation

Transportation to the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame is on your own. From New York, you can get to Cleveland Ohio by car, airplane, or Amtrak train from New York City's Penn Station directly to the Cleveland Amtrak station.

If there is enough interest, the school will look into chartering <u>a coach bus</u> or buses for everyone to travel as a group. The initial estimate we have is approximately \$90 per person round trip to take the bus, as an additional charge. However, we do need enough interested people, as we cannot book a bus for one person. If we do book a bus, the bus would leave New York on Friday, August 14th, 2020, and return to New York on Sunday, August 16th, 2020. Upon your registration, we will ask if you are interested in taking the bus, and how many in your party will be on the bus in order to ascertain enough interest.

The school has a block of rooms set aside at a discounted rate at the **Cleveland Marriott Downtown at Key Tower** for **\$159/ night** (normally \$240/ night) for the nights of Friday, August 14^{th,} 2020 and Saturday, August 15^{th,} 2020. The hotel is walking distance to the Rock & Roll Hall of fame, at no more than 0.7 miles away. All rooms are first come, first served and once the room block is sold out families may need to either pay full rate or find other lodging on their own. Once registered, we will send you an email with the reservation link for our hotel blocks.

Instruments

The Rock & Roll Hall Of Fame will be providing a Grand Piano, as well as a Drum Set for our use. Guitarists, violinists, and woodwinds all need to bring their own instrument(s). Please speak to your instructor about the best way to pack your instrument and amplifiers for travel.
